Impact to date:

- Learning skills and confidence has increased for individual pupils and part of this can be attributed to the interventions that have been put in place and the additional resources that we have been able to purchase.
- 22 pupils benefitted from booster sessions in Numeracy and 17 benefitted from booster sessions in writing in Y6, during and after the school day. In addition, 28 children had extra tuition in either Maths or English. 72% of those pupils in Y6 made accelerated progress during the year.
- Our end of Key Stage 2 targets at level 4+ were met in Maths, although not quite in English overall. However, we exceeded our English target at level 5.
- Whole School Training in approaches to writing meant improvements on the previous year's progress across the school were noted.
- It is hard to measure the specific impact of educational visits, but we believe they enhance our curriculum for all pupils and offer wider opportunities and experiences that they might otherwise not experience.
- The school will look further at how to use the grant in future to narrow the gap in attainment of specific groups of children and particularly those on free school meals.
